# WESTMORELAND COUNTY'S EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (ERAP)

The Emergency Rental Assistance Program was created to assist those that were directly or indirectly impacted by the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency.\*

The ERAP Funds will be used to provide families and individuals financial assistance for rent, rental arrears, utilities and home energy costs, home energy costs arrears, and other expenses related to housing incurred due, directly or indirectly to COVID-19 and also providing housing stability services to eligible households.



### Who is Eligible?

An eligible renter household has at least one person who:

- Has qualified for unemployment benefits or experienced a cut in income, incurred significant costs or experienced other hardship due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.
- Is at risk of experiencing homelessness. Risk factors include:
  - Has past due utility bills or rent or has an eviction notice.
  - Is living in unsafe or unhealthy conditions.
- Has a household income at or below 80 percent of the Westmoreland County area median income (AMI).

#### Income

Household income is determined as either the household's total income for calendar year 2020 or the household's monthly income at the time of application.

#### **Eligible Expenses**

- Current and past due rent
- Current and past due utility bills
