

**RESOLUTION NO. 3 OF 2021**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW FLORENCE, COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING INTER-MUNICIPAL COOPERATION IN THE PURCHASE OF CODE/ORDINANCE ENFORCEMENT SERVICE FROM THE BOROUGH OF SEWARD**

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Florence, wishes to purchase code/ordinance enforcement service from the Borough of Seward; and


WHEREAS, cooperation among the said municipalities in the performance of their governmental powers and duties is authorized by Article IX, Section 5 of the Pennsylvania Constitution, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 53 Pa.C.S. § 2301 et. seq. and the Borough Code, 8 P.S. §§ 1121 and 1202 (24); and

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Florence believes that participation in a contract to provide code enforcement service to its citizens will be in the best interest of the Borough and its citizens;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it hereby is enacted and ordained, by the Council of the Borough of New Florence, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania:


**Section 1.** The Borough is hereby authorized through its appropriate officers to execute an agreement to obtain code/ordinance enforcement service from the Borough of Seward, on terms that Council shall deem appropriate, and authorizes the President of Borough Council to execute same upon approval by Council.
