

ORDINANCE NO. 108

PROVIDING FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND BUILDINGS  
IN THE BOROUGH OF NEW FLORENCE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of New Florence, County of Westmoreland, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. The residents and/or the business people of the Borough of New Florence shall number their houses and/or their places of business according to the numbering plan adopted by Council on the 14th day of September, 1965.

SECTION 2. Said numerals shall be no less than two (2) inches high and shall be displayed where they will be visible from the street on which the house and/or place of business faces.

SECTION 3. The penalty for violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be a fine of not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars and not more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) plus the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of fine and costs, the defendant shall be sentenced to be confined in jail for a period not to exceed more than ten (10) days. Each day's continuance of violations of the provisions of the ordinance shall constitute a separate offense. Enforcement of these provisions shall be by Summary Proceedings before the Mayor or a Justice of the Peace.
