

ORDINANCE NO. 114

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF TRUCKS AND BUSES ON THE BOROUGH STREETS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION, THE BOROUGH OF NEW FLORENCE HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS;

- SECTION 1. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO PARK TRUCKS AND BUSES UPON ANY OF THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS AND STREETS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF AND FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF WHICH THE BOROUGH OF NEW FLORENCE IS RESPONSIBLE.
- SECTION 2. TRUCKS AS REFERRED TO IN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE ALL THOSE TRUCKS OVER FIVE (5) TONS.
- SECTION 3. TRUCKS AND BUSES UNDER THIS ORDINANCE MAY PARK FOR THE PURPOSE OF DELIVERY AND PICK UP SERVICE.
- SECTION 4. ANY PERSON VIOLATING THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE GUILTY OF A SUMMARY OFFENSE AND UPON CONVICTION THEREOF BEFORE THE MAYOR OR BEFORE ANY JUSTICE OF THE PEACE OF WESTMORELAND COUNTY SHALL BE SENTENCED A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$50.00, TOGETHER WITH COSTS OF PROSECUTION, AND IN DEFAULT OF SUCH PAYMENT AND COSTS, TO IMPRISONMENT OF NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) DAYS.
- SECTION 5. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HERewith ARE HEREBY REPEALED.
- SECTION 6. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW APPLICABLE THERETO, FIVE DAYS AFTER THE ADOPTION HEREOF.
