ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE OFFICES OF SECRETARY AND TREASURER TO BE COMBINED INTO ONE OFFICE HELD BY ONE INDIVIDUAL, THE BOROUGH OF NEW FLORENCE HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 1. THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW FLORENCE SHALL BY THIS ORDINANCE BE ABOLISHED.
- SECTION 2. THE OFFICE OF TREASURER OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW FLORENCE SHALL BE THIS ORDINANCE BE ABOLISHED.
- SECTION 3. THERE SHALL BE ESTABLISHED AN OFFICE DESIGNATED AS SECRETARY-TREASURER TO BE HELD BY ONE INDIVIDUAL.
- THE OFFICE OF SECRETARY-TREASURER OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW FLORENCE SECTION 4. SHALL BE ENDOWED WITH ALL POWERS GRANTED TO THE INDIVIDUAL OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY AND ALSO THOSE POWERS GRANTED TO THE OFFICE OF THE TREASURER.
- SECTION 5. ALL THOSE DUTIES PERFORMED MERETOFORE BY THE SECRETARY, AND ALL THOSE DUTIES PERFORMED HERETOFORE BY THE TREASURER, SHALL BE PER-FORMED BY THE OFFICER DESIGNATED AS THE SECRETARY-TREASURER.
- SECTION 6. THE INDIVIDUAL HOLDING THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY-TREASURER OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW FLORENCE SHALL BE CHOSEN IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH BOROUGH CODE OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AND THE PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED BY THE COUNCIL OF NEW FLORENCE BOROUGH FOR THE ELECTION OF OTHER VALID, LAWFUL OFFICES.
- SECTION 7. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH ARE HEREBY REPEALED.
- SECTION 8. THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE JANUARY 1, 1969. ENACTED AND ORDAINED THIS 5TH DAY OF MARCH, 1969.
