

ORDINANCE No. 147

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CONSUMPTION OF
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN PUBLIC AREAS
WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF NEW FLORENCE

SECTION 1

Whereas the council of New Florence borough has determined that the safety and welfare of the citizens of New Florence Borough will be enhanced by prohibiting the consumption of alcoholic beverages in public areas within the Borough of New Florence; it is hereby ordained:

SECTION 2

That no person shall consume alcoholic beverages in public areas, including but not limited to streets, sidewalks, playgrounds and parking lots, within the borough of New Florence.

SECTION 3

That any person or persons convicted of violating any provisions of this Ordinance shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for a first conviction, and upon any subsequent conviction shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars nor more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance shall become effective on the 24TH day of

February, 1981.
