ORDINANCE NO. 45

Regulating the erection and maintenance of gasoline, service and repair stations within the Borough of New Florence, and providing penalties for the violation of said ordinance.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Borough of New Florence, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that from and after the passage of this ordinance, no gasoline, service or repair station, nor pumps or machinery of any kind in connection therewith, for the sale of gas and oils or the repair of automobiles or other motor vehicles, shall be erected, maintained, or operated outside of the property line of the owner or lessee of the premises upon which the same shall be maintained or operated.

SECTION 2. No gas tank shall be buried or maintained under the sidewalks of any street or alley in said Borough, but the same shall be wholly within the property lines of the owner or lessee of the premises upon which the same shall be maintained.

SECTION 3. No automobile or other motor vehicle shall be repaired upon the streets or alleys of said Borough, except the temporary repairs necessary to remove tires and substitute others, or remove the same to a regular garage or service station for the necessary and permanent repairs.

SECTION 4. Before the erection of any new gasoline, service or repair stations hereafter within said Borough, the plans thereof shall first be submitted to Council for the approval of the approaches thereto across the sidewalks, and as to the location of the gas tanks thereof.

SECTION 5. All persons, owners or lessees of property in connection with the gasoline, service or repair stations, or any owner of a motor vehicle, driver or person using or operating the same, who shall offend against any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof before the Chief Burgess of the said Borough, or before any Justice of the Peace of said County, pay a fine of not less than five (\$5.00) dollars, nor more than ten (\$10.00) dollars for each day so offending, and the costs of each offense, and in default thereof shall be committed to the County jail for a period of not more than five (5) days.
