

ORDINANCE NO. 69

Prohibiting the dumping, placing or spreading rubbish, garbage, stove or furnace ashes on the streets, alleys or highways within the borough limits of the Borough of New Florence.

SECTION 1. Be it ordained and enacted by the Borough of New Florence, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that from and after the passage of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, partnerships of Corporations to dump, place or spread any rubbish, garbage, stove or furnace ashes, or any refuse material whatsoever on any street, alley or highway within the limits of the Borough of New Florence.

SECTION 2. Any person or persons, partnerships or Corporations, violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof before the chief Burgess of the said Borough, or before any Justice of the Peace of said County, pay a fine not exceeding twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars and costs for each offense, and in default thereof shall be committed to the County jail for a period of not less than five (5) days nor more than ten (10) days.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
