

ORDINANCE NUMBER 95

To regulate water taps & water lines

WHEREAS, Council wishes to further regulate water taps and water lines, therefore

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW FLORENCE ORDAINS,

That:

1. A water tap is not to be made until a tap fee of \$50.00 is paid to Council, and this includes making a tap from one house to another.
2. The tap fee of \$50.00 must be paid sixty (60) days before the tap is to be installed.
3. Anyone wanting a water line more than 200 feet from an existing water line inside the Borough must pay the cost of the pipe and installation beyond the 200 feet.
4. Persons living beyond the Borough line must lay their own water lines to the Borough line and must have these lines inspected by the water committee before a tap is made.
5. No water tap will be made outside the Borough except where the Borough has taken over the water lines, and the property owners must install a valve inside their dwelling so that the water can be shut off when inside repairs have to be made.
6. Property owners must pay for work done on the property side of the curb boxes when leaks occur.

A fine of \$25.00 and/or five (5) days imprisonment is hereby imposed upon anyone found guilty of making a tap or attaching a line in any way without first paying a \$50.00 tap fee. It shall be the duty of the Chief of Police to enforce the fine imposed by this ordinance by summary proceedings before the Mayor of the Borough of New Florence.
