New Florence Borough S.R. 711 & 1001 Speed Limit review

Dear Mr. Moore:

This letter is in response to your letter, dated March 26, 2021, requesting a traffic study be performed on State Route (S.R.) 711 and S.R. 1001 to determine if the speed limits on these State Routes can be reduced from 35 mph to 25 mph within the Borough limits of New Florence Borough, Westmoreland County.

The Department recently completed a speed study along S.R. 711 and S.R. 1001 for the requested area within the borough to determine the accurate speed limit for this roadway. The study was completed in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) and Publication §212 (Official Traffic Control Devices).

The results of the study revealed that the existing 35 mph speed limit on S.R. 711 is the correct speed limit for this roadway through the borough. The results of this study also revealed that warrants are met for a 25 mph speed limit on S.R. 1001 for the section of roadway within the borough limits. The signs necessary to post these zones shall be erected and maintained by the municipality as per Publication §212.108(e). The revised permit for the S.R. 1001 speed limit has been included for your reference.
