ORDINANCE NO. 2 of 2004

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE LEVY OF A TAX ON ALL
REAL PROPERTY SITUATE IN THE BOROUGH OF NEW
FLORENCE FOR GENERAL BOROUGH REVENUE PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of New Florence is charged with the annual determination of a budget to cover anticipate expenditures by the borough in accordance with Sections 1307 through 1310 of the Pennsylvania Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of New Florence is further charged by Section 1310 of the Pennsylvania Borough Code with the adoption of an ordinance to establish and levy taxes in support of the budget as adopted; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of New Florence has now determined that an increase is necessary to the millage rate charged on assessed values of real property within the Borough of New Florence in order to meet budgetary requirements and cover anticipated expenditures by the borough in 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of New Florence, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1: The Council of the Borough of New Florence has determined that proper budget consideration for 2025 requires an increase in real estate tax millage rate in order to maintain the current level of municipal services.

SECTION 2: Beginning January 1, 2025, the tax levied on all real property situate in the Borough of New Florence, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, for general Borough revenue purposes shall be increased by One-Half (0.5) mill and thereafter be fixed at the sum of twenty-one (21) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation based on a one hundred (100%) percent evaluation as established by the Westmoreland County Tax Assessment Office.

SECTION 4: A late penalty of ten (10) percent shall be added to real estate taxes levied hereunder which are paid after the stated due date.

SECTION 5: The rate of tax established and levied hereby shall remain in place until a further Ordinance of the Council of the Borough of New Florence shall be adopted changing the millage rate set forth herein.

SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances not in accord with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent they conflict herewith.
