ORDINANCE No. _____ of 2022 "TAX ORDINANCE FOR 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW FLORENCE COUNCIL, COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR 2023 ESTABLISHING THE REAL ESTATE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2023

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Florence("the BOROUGH") is authorized pursuant to the Borough Code (8 Pa.C.S. § 1302) to levy a tax for general revenue purposes upon the assessed value of real estate within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, in order to establish sufficient revenues to meet anticipated Borough expenses, it is necessary to set tax rates;

NOW THEREFORE, the following is ordained and enacted:

- 1. The New Florence Borough Budget for 2023 is set at \$ 291,051.00
- 1. The Borough hereby establishes a tax upon the assessed value of real estate of 20.50 mills for general revenue purposes for calendar year 2023. The rate of taxation in dollars and cents on each \$100.00 of assessed valuation of taxable property shall be \$2.05.
- 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 2023.
- 3. All prior ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
